- It's still crunch time. I received an extension for submittal of the book for March 15th. This enables us to get the Daddy daughter dance and Kindergarten performance photos into the book. I'm still running around getting last minute missing photos of students/teachers and pulling the rest of the book together. I'm using my squeaky wheel mobile portrait studio. Thank you Crystal for lending backdrop and thank you Library for lending easel on wheels. Almost there- home stretch.
- Any events taking place after March 15th, I will put a QR code and url in the book that will link to our yearbook page on the gators pta website. This link will have content for those future events (extra pages to be able to download for the yearbook). So even if we get new students in the Spring, they can still be added to the digital content. I could put a page like: Welcome New Gators with photo, name, etc., and we could include the mother/son field day and the end of school year field day.
- Yearbook sales as of 3/6/2018: Ad space has brought in roughly \$1,160 minus the online square fees. That enables us to purchase 46 yearbooks for folks who can't afford them. So far, no online applications for the free yearbooks, I'll push more that later in the year. Right now, we will donate 1 yearbook for a silent auction basket. If we don't get many applications for free yearbooks, we could possible look at giving them to teachers. I'd like to get a consensus on that after I send home the free yearbook application paper forms. The process would be any applicants would be reviewed by the administration and financial need can be determined.
- I'm adding the 46 books to our sales. Total sales for yearbooks: 196 (\$4,940). Our target is 350 books per contract with Strawbridge.
